Andrew Myers is the Founder and CEO of RippleMatch, the recruitment automation platform changing how Gen Z finds work. He attended Yale University, where he studied history and earned Phi Beta Kappa honors before leaving to found RippleMatch. He has been named to Forbes 30 Under 30, Forbes Magazine's Next 1000, and the Top 100 Yale Alumni in Technology. Andrew founded RippleMatch to change the current system of early career recruiting: Instead of top employers only visiting and hiring students from prestigious schools, he wanted to make it possible for employers to build relationships with the right students from a wide variety of geographic, socioeconomic and racial backgrounds. Since starting in Andrew's college dorm room in 2016, RippleMatch has expanded to 1500 college campuses, raised \$80 million in venture funding, and built deep partnerships with employers like Pinterest, General Mills, SAP, and EY. Their 128 person team is headquartered in New York City.
